Key tasks will include:

- Ensure staff maintain the appearance of all vehicles at an optimum level;
- Ensure vehicles are cleaned to the GRID standard specification;
- Report of any defects in the vehicle or equipment;
- Maintain a clean and tidy service area;
- Ensure staff use personal protection equipment (PPE) as trained;
- Assist other team workers if required to ensure vehicles are ready for dispatch;
- Be able to communicate with client site staff
- Undertake any other duties as operationally directed
- To attend work in clean uniform provided.

- Working collaboratively as a member of the fleet presentation team.
- Participating in the growth and development of the team.
- Maintaining a current Drivers' License.

4 CONFIDENTIALITY Ensuring business confidentiality by:

• Protecting the confidentiality of staff, company business information and practices.

Physical Abilities /Requirements
